Our pupils achieved excellent outcomes across the school. Year 1 phonics reached 88.2%, above both local and national figures. In the Year 4 Multiplication Tables Check, our average score was 23 out of 25, with 57.6% of pupils gaining full marks.

The combined result rose from 34.5% last year to 66.7% this year. We also achieved strong greater depth results in reading, writing and the combined measure.
